About: STEM Camp this summer at CACC Betty Carol Graham Center

CACC is hosting a workshop this summer for high school students that will be juniors or seniors **next** year. The title, STEM, stands for Science, Technology, Engineering and Math. The objective of the workshop is to inform students about some of the opportunities available in these subject areas and give them some idea of what sort of activities are involved should they choose to pursue a degree in these areas.

There will be two identical workshops, one the first week of June (actually June 6 – June 10) and another one the second week of June. Both workshops will be held in the BCG Building on the Alex City Campus and will begin promptly at 8:00 AM on Monday, June 6 the first week and 8:00 AM on Monday, June 13 the second week.

The format of the workshop is designed to be informative, entertaining, and even a bit financially rewarding, since participants will each receive a \$100 stipend upon completion of the workshop. They will also be paid mileage. (Students **must** attend all 5 days in order to receive the stipend and mileage, it is part of the grant stipulations.)

A mid-morning snack and Lunch will be provided FREE.

The STEM camp will be conducted from 8:00 - 3:00 each day, except for the first day, which ends at 5 PM.

Students must provide their own transportation to CACC.
