About: STEM Camp this summer at CACC Betty Carol Graham Center

CACC is hosting two workshops this summer, the first for students who will be in grades 5 through 8 **next year**, and the second for students who will be in grades 9 through 12 **next** year. The title, STEM, stands for Science, Technology, Engineering and Math. The objective of the workshop is to inform students about some of the opportunities available in these subject areas and give them some idea of what sort of activities are involved should they choose to pursue a degree in these areas.

There will be two identical workshops, the first, for grades 5 through 8, June 5 - 9, and the second, for grades 9 – 12, June 12 - 16. Both workshops will be held in the BCG Building on the Alex City Campus and will begin promptly at 8:00 AM on Monday each week.

The format of the workshop is designed to be informative, entertaining, and may even be a bit financially rewarding. Participants are divided up into 2 person teams for the robotics portion of the workshop, (the first two days), which is competition based learning. Winners of this competition will each receive \$50.

A mid-morning snack and Lunch will be provided FREE.
The STEM camp will be conducted from 8:00 - 3:00 each day.
Students must provide their own transportation to CACC.
